

The iPhone — More than Just a Phone!

Pt. 1: Maps & GPS

- I. Apple Maps
 - A. Overview, Intro, and Questions
 - B. Searching for your location — typing in the search bar
 - 1. Find directions via Drive, Walk, Transit, and Ride at the bottom
 - 2. Tap the little “i” with the circle at the top right to turn traffic on
 - C. Browsing Local Services & Recent Places — after tapping the search bar the list
 - D. Locating yourself — hitting the blue arrow in the upper right
 - 1. Tap again to show the direction your phone is facing
 - E. Finding local attractions in your area — pinch/expand on the screen
 - F. Learning more about an attraction — tap on the icon
 - 1. Pull up from the bottom to see more info, including pictures/reviews/website, directions etc.
 - G. Activating GPS — hit Directions
 - 1. Hit GO to begin navigation
 - 2. Swipe up from bottom to see alternate routes
 - 3. Tap Driving Options to avoid toll roads, highways, etc.
 - H. Finding Gas Stations or other stops — tap the bar at the bottom
 - 1. Swipe up from bottom to see the different destinations, distance, reviews, etc.
 - I. See more Details of your Trip — tap bar at bottom during navigation to find Overview, Details, etc.
 - 1. Tap the top bar while navigating to see the overview

 - C. Reporting Hazards — tapping the orange bubble symbol in the lower right
